A multidisciplinary module

- A five-day learning project which combined literature, science, arts, drama and languages.
- For all 5th graders of our school.
- The students were divided into four groups by their interests.
- An introduction day: information on Baltic Sea and the author Tove Jansson
- An excursion day: a planetarium film about life under the sea in a science center
- Two workshop days: drama, animation, posters, comics, quizzes etc.
- A sharing day: showing the others the previous activities.



Reading books

- During the week, every pupil read a Moomin book in Finnish and in Russian, and some also in English.
- The aim was to raise the appreciation of reading and literature.



The workshops

- creative methods:
- drama
- animation
- comics and posters
- creating quizzes
- The pupils where encouraged to deal with protecting the Baltic Sea in their work.

Ideas for collaboration with other BSP schools

- Schools in different Baltic Sea countries could choose from authors who have a special relationship to the sea or who have written about environmental issues.
- The students could read books and discuss them online.
- Videos, animation, drama, comics etc. inspired by the books and share them with students in a different country.
