

THE NORDPLUS JUNIOR PROGRAMME MAKES IT POSSIBLE TO APPLY FOR GRANTS FOR COOPERATION WITH SCHOOLS IN THE NORDIC AND BALTIC COUNTRIES, SUCH AS FOR PROJECT PARTNERSHIPS, PUPIL AND TEACHER EXCHANGES AND WORK EXPERIENCE FOR PUPILS.

IT IS ALSO POSSIBLE TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FOR PREPARATORY VISITS TO DISCUSS AND DEVELOP PROJECT PLANS WITH POTENTIAL PARTNERS.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Nordplus Junior is aimed at preschools, primary and secondary schools, both theoretical and vocational programmes, as well as vocational schools/apprenticeships. Extended schools in arts and culture that are part of a national or regional school syllabus may apply as coordinators.
