

Miten FoE:en päädyttiin

- Pariisin Unesco-koulujen sihteeristö kutsui maakoordinaattorien kautta Unesco-kouluja mukaan kesällä 2020 tulevaisuushankkeeseen
- tehtävänä ennen kaikkea oppilaille:
- kuvata vuotta 2050: mitä haluavat /eivät halua nähdä silloin
- Mitä globaali- ja kestävän kehityksen kasvatuksen keinoin voi tehdä, että vuosi 2050 olisi hyvä vuosi ja maailma kestävällä tolalla?

Miten FoE:en päädyttiin

- Suomessa U-tiimi innostui ja Unesco-koulujen vuosiseminaarissa 1-2.9.2020 meidän kouluja pyydettiin alustavasti mukaan
- Lokakuussa Suomen-versio kutsusta kaikille Unesco-kouluille: rakenteellisesti helpotettu versio – ei tingitty sisällöstä!
- Aikaa vuoden 2020 loppuun, >50% kouluista osallistui
- Vastauksista laadittiin huolellinen raportti tammikuussa 2021, jaettu Pariisiin sekä OKM/Suomen Unesco-toimikunnalle
- Suomi todennäköisesti ahkerin: eniten vastaajia, vastauksia, raportoinnilla haetaan vakavasti jatkotoimia
